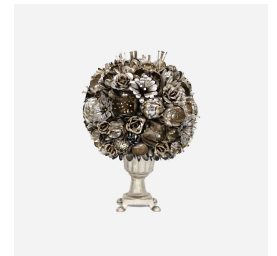
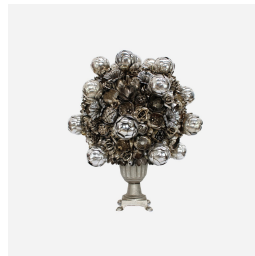
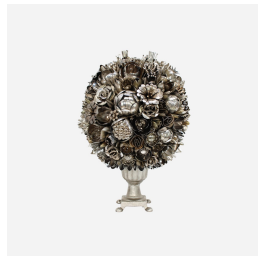
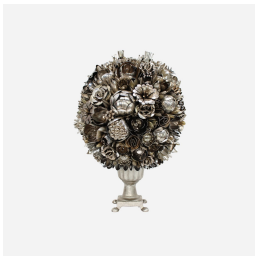


ANN CARRINGTON
